

Proposal Olivia Hendrickx Research Fund Bench Fee linked to a Fellowship provided by external agency

The OHRF will provide bench fees to support fellowships in pediatric oncology awarded by external agencies without a bench fee.

The projects should aim at the improvement of treatment and care of pediatric cancer patient. The translation of scientific knowledge to clinical practice is the primary aim. The OHRF will support both part-time clinical PhD projects and full time PhD projects. The practical research can also be performed in an university laboratory.
